

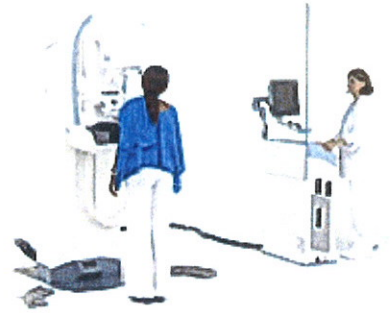
Sequoyah Memorial Hospital
2017 Mammography Project

*Sequoyah Memorial has been providing the community mammography services since 1986 – over 30years.

*Our Radiologist group, Diagnostic Imaging, provides an annual report to the physicians. DIA has confirmed the incidence of breast cancer in our region of the state is 3 times the national average.

*To meet new mandatory requirements, the hospital is replacing the current analog equipment with a state of the art digital machine. The project is approximately \$300,000.00. Sequoyah Memorial applied for a Susan G. Komen grant and was awarded this \$125,000.00 grant in December. Walmart has also donated \$1,500.00. We are submitting a USDA \$50,000.00 grant application.

*Recently two local families (Cook and Herndon) have arranged their memorial contributions to be given to SMH projects.



*Our goal is to be completed with the project and have an open-house celebration by early summer.

FDA mandating this conversion to be complete by 12/31/17 or organization can no longer provide Mammography

SMH has been performing Mammography since 1986
